MEMBERSHIP FEES

Membership is from January 1st – December 31st in the same year. Fees are as follows:

Underage - €40 Student - €50 Adults - €90 Family - €130

Note: Family membership can be paid in two instalments. Members that join after the Irish Coastal Rowing Championships in August must pay a fee of €25 for until December. Receipts will be given on all payments.

REGISTRATION

All members must also register with Rowing Ireland. A separate form & fee, and will require a copy of your Birth Certificate and 2 recent passport photographs.

FOR THE 2018 SEASON ONLY, ALL MEMBERS, NEW AND EXISTING, WILL NEED TO PROVIDE A COPY OF THEIR BIRTH CERT AND/OR PASSPORT/DRIVING LICENCE. THIS IS FOR REGISTRATION WITH ROWING IRELAND.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

When scheduled, an additional €2 for underage, and €3 for adult members, is required to attend circuit training classes which are provided by a professional instructor. ERG training carries a fee of €1 per session. All members must sign in each time that they use the gym or attend rowing on the strand. Members are asked to familiarise themselves with the Club Rules, Constitution and Club Policies.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Anyone wishing to become a member of the Club must fill out an application form and provide two (2) passport size photographs together with the appropriate fee. Forms are available from the Membership and Registration Officer. Membership runs from January 1st – December 31st each year. Existing members must be paid up by 1st March and new members upon entry.
2. All Club Members must abide with our Club Constitution, Club Rules, Club Policies and Club Code of Best Practice.
3. All of our Club Constitution, Club Rules, Club Policies and Club Code of Best Practice are in use when any member is involved with Club business on the Strand, Gym or representing the Club on away trips.
4. All members are asked to keep themselves familiar with Club activities and to participate where possible.
5. The boats can only be used when a committee member is present, except at the discretion of the committee.
6. Anybody found to be using the boat in the absence of a committee member will be disqualified from the club.
7. All coxes must wear a Life Jacket / Buoyancy aid at all times on the water.
8. A set of Life Jackets/Buoyancy aids must be available at all times for adult crews.
9. All underage crews must wear Life Jackets/Buoyancy aids at all times on the water.
10. All members must take due care of the boats, oars and all Club equipment.
11. The boats are to be washed and cleaned once a week.
12. Boats must be stowed properly after use.
13. Oars are not to be used to push the boat off the strand.
14. All members must take due care to avoid rubbing the boats on stones on the strand.
15. The rudder must be removed before coming ashore.
16. The oars must be stowed in the boat when not in use.
17. All crews when racing must wear the official Club Jerseys.
18. All members of the Club will behave decently while taking part in Club activities and will not do anything to bring the Club into disrepute.
19. Offences and the penalties carry:
 - a. Anyone under the age of 18 found to be taking alcoholic drink while on Club activities:
First Offence: Suspension for three (3) weeks
Second Offence: Exclusion from the club
 - b. Anyone over the age of 18 who takes alcoholic drink before a race or misbehaves under the influence of alcoholic drink while on Club Activities:
First Offence: Suspension for three (3) weeks
Second Offence: Exclusion from the club
 - c. Interfering with other peoples property while taking part in Club activities:
First Offence: Suspension for three (3) weeks
Second Offence: Exclusion from the club
 - d. Use of foul language
 - e. Abusing any individual Club member, committee member, steward, starters or regatta committees.
 - f. Intimidating other Club members or other Clubs
 - g. Booing other Clubs at regattas
 - h. Not obeying the persons in charge
 - i. Throwing stones on the beach during training and regattas
 - j. Messing in the boat
First Offence: Suspension for three (3) weeks
Second Offence: Exclusion from the club
***Except that exclusion is at the discretion of the committee**
 - k. Any member who is selected to take part in the regatta and does not turn up without due cause.
Suspension for four (4) weeks

NOTE

If the CRA finds the Club guilty of any offence from (a) to (g) at a regatta, the Club may be banned from two (2) Race Meetings.

Children who are not rowing, will not be taken to Regattas unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Underage members with serious allergies, MUST have a parent/guardian present at all times (training & regattas)

People using transport arranged through the Club will be given a departure time and may be left behind if late.
